

## EPSDT Services

The well-child visit (EPSDT) program includes check-ups and treatment for any problems found during the check-ups. These services are called EPSDT services. Care1st will send you a reminder when it is time for your child to have a check-up.

Even when your child is not sick, it is important to see a PCP regularly. These visits can help the PCP find problems early and begin treating your child right away. There is no charge for these services, and they will help your child stay healthy.

### **Well-child visits (EPSDT) include, but are not limited to:**

- + Complete physical exam
- + Health and developmental history and assessment
- + Nutrition assessment
- + Dental screening
- + Behavioral health screening
- + Shots (immunizations)
- + Speech, hearing and eye exams
- + Tests for tuberculosis (TB) and anemia
- + Lab tests (including blood lead screening)
- + Health education and discussion about your child's health
- + Follow-up for any problems found during these check-ups will be covered

### Make an appointment with your child's PCP for check-ups at the following ages:
