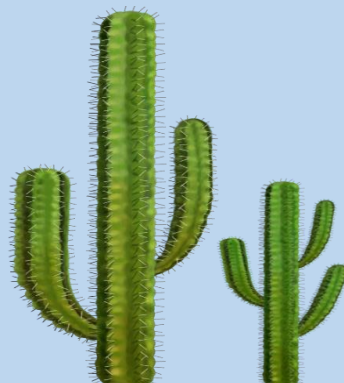
Maricopa County is partnering with pharmacies & school districts to host COVID-19 vaccination events around the Valley for K-12 school staff & childcare workers.

You are eligible if you work for a:

- Public K-12 school
- Private K-12 school
- Charter K-12 school
- Childcare facility
- Home-based child care if you provide care for 5 or more children who do not live with you

These events are only for those with scheduled appointments. Proof of eligibility is required at time of vaccination.

FREE SERVICES

Housing up to 10 days from start of symptoms

3 meals prepared and delivered freshly

Kitchenettes for those who prefer to prepare their own meals

Weekly laundry service

Transportation to and from hotel and medical appointments

Cable TV, internet, local phone, microwave, small refrigerator, and coffee pot

ELIGIBILITY

- Unable to isolate in a bedroom and bathroom by yourself that nobody else can use
- Must be able to care of yourself without assistance (there is no medical staff onsite)
- High risk individuals who live with infected family or roommates

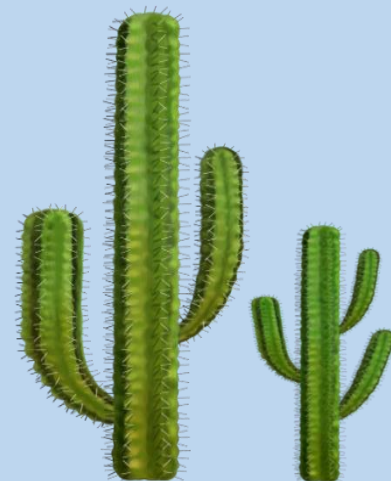

Socialserve is a nonprofit, bilingual call center that connects people to housing and provides supportive, second chance employment. We provide professional housing location and listing services across the United States through our partnership with Emphasys Software.

We also assist displaced households in finding new housing, offer waiting list opening support, and gather housing data on behalf of many organizations across the country.
